According to a recently released report of the IEA "the number of announced projects for low-emission hydrogen production is rapidly expanding. Annual production of low-emission hydrogen could reach 38 Mt in 2030, if all announced projects are realized". Latin America is in the running for the implementation of this kind of projects and its contribution to the production of green and blue H2 is essential, thanks to the availability of renewable energetic sources and an advanced basic energy industry.
